## Slide Shows

I used My SlideShow to create the slide show. You can click this link: <http://www.anixsoft.com/> to learn more about the program. To play a slide show, press a text button on the autorun menu. You will have three options to view photos:



1. Filmstrip--Displays the current photo in a larger window and a thumbnail view or small view of the next 8 photos below. Clicking on the thumbnail will automatically enlarge the photo.

2. Previews--Show the entire photo album with small thumbnails. Double click on a photo to enlarge the image. At the bottom of the photo, you will find a description of the photo that includes the photo name.

3. Slide Show--plays the still photos with music. The slide show will fill the screen and automatically show the photos with music.

## Printing Photos

In the past, I had good results printing pictures on photo grade glossy paper with my Epson 785EPX inkjet. I then started to upload the images to a printing service, such as Mira or Photo Access, for output on photographic paper as prints. I really recommend uploading or professional printing rather than printing on a home inkjet printer. Professional printing last longer and is cheaper to buy than to print at home. YES, by the time I bought the paper and ink, it was cheaper to print them professionally. If you live in Klamath Falls, I placed a CD at Leo's Camera store. The CD contains high resolution photos from the slide show that you can print for personal use. Leo's does great work! *Please do not ask to copy photos or take the CD.*
